

ORDER

On Friday, July 1, 2011, counsel for the parties appeared before the Court and presented argument on plaintiffs’ Motion to Compel Production and for Costs Incurred (Docket no. 179) (“Motion to Compel”) and on defendant’s Motion for a Protective Order (Docket no. 182) (“Motion for Protective Order”). Upon consideration of the motions, plaintiffs’ memorandum in support of their Motion to Compel (Docket no. 180), defendant’s memorandum in support of his Motion for Protective Order (Docket no. 183) and supplemental declaration (Docket no. 193), plaintiffs’ opposition to defendant’s Motion for Protective Order (Docket no. 190), the arguments of counsel, and for the reasons stated from the bench, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion to Compel is granted in part and denied in part. Defendant shall serve full and complete responses to plaintiffs’ discovery requests by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, July 8, 2011. It is further

ORDERED that the Motion for Protective Order is granted in part and denied in part. Unless extraordinary circumstances justifying further delay are presented to the court before Tuesday, July 19, 2011, defendant’s deposition shall begin on that date in the manner agreed to by the parties.
