

CHAMPION OF JUSTICE AWARD

The Champion of Justice Award recognizes extraordinary contributions to the field of human rights. We are proud to recognize two incredible woman journalists this year.

Susan Meiselas is a renowned documentary photographer who spent five decades documenting human stories across the globe. She is particularly known for exposing human rights issues in El Salvador during the civil war and in Nicaragua during times of the Somoza dictatorship. As a journalist, she has turned an unflinching, insightful, and ultimately, compassionate eye on victims, survivors, and their communities. Susan's courageous work reveals the complex stories of those often overlooked in times of conflict, and has made a profound impact on photographic truth-telling. She is a MacArthur Fellow and the winner of



JUDITH LEE STRONACH AWARD

The Judith Lee Stronach Award honors individuals and organizations that have made an outstanding contribution to the movement for global justice. The Alliance of Victim-Led Organisation, AVLO is a women-led movement for justice and accountability in The Gambia. It is playing a crucial role in the creation of a war crimes court in The Gambia for atrocities committed under Yahya Jammeh's dictatorship, which lasted from 1994 to 2017. Jammeh's 22-year rule was marked by widespread abuses, including torture, enforced disappearances, and extrajudicial killings. The efforts of these eight organizations have been vital in securing justice for victims both inside and outside The Gambia. We honor their courage and perseverance in seeking healing in the wake of atrocity, not only for themselves but for their communities, and for the mending of the country for future generations.

The Partner in Justice Award recognizes the remarkable partnerships that make CJA's work possible. **Freshfields LLP** is CJA's co-counsel in Mzaik v. Syria, which seeks to hold the Syrian government accountable for the widespread and systematic use of torture in its detention centers. Today, more than 130,000 Syrians reportedly remain missing or arbitrarily detained – the vast majority either presumed dead or simply disappeared into the Syrian prison system. Mobilizing its international network of lawyers, Freshfields has partnered with CJA and Syrian human rights defenders to build a case reflecting these ongoing abuses with incredible breadth and depth.
