PLAINTIFFS' EMERGENCY MOTION FOR PROTECTIVE ORDER TO BAR HARASSMENT AND INTIMIDATION OF PARTIES AND WITNESSES

Pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 26(c) and this Court's inherent powers, plaintiffs David Boniface ("David"), Nissandère Martyr¹ ("Nissandère"), and Juders Yseme ("Juders") (collectively "Plaintiffs") hereby file this motion for an emergency protective order barring any further harassment, intimidation, and/or physical harm of Plaintiffs and witnesses by defendant Jean Morose Viliena ("Defendant). As grounds for this Motion, Plaintiffs respectfully submit the attached memorandum of law.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth in the memorandum of law, and based on the declarations of Juders Ysemé and Bonnie Lau, Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Court grant their Motion, and enter an Order barring Defendant Viliena from engaging in any actions, either directly or through orders to his agents, designed to intimidate, harass, or physically harm Plaintiffs, their families, or any potential witnesses disclosed as part of Plaintiffs' initial

disclosures pursuant to Fed.R.Civ.P. 26(a)(1) set forth in Exhibit 1. Further, should Defendant continue to violate the Court's order not to threaten or harm Plaintiffs and/or witnesses, Plaintiffs request that the Order provide that they may seek monetary or evidentiary sanctions against Defendant.
