ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR RELIEF FROM STAY

A hearing was held February 21, 2012, on the Motion (Docket No. 4) for Relief From Stay filed on behalf of Bashe Abdi Yousuf, Buralle Salah Mohamoud, Ahmed Jama Gulaid, and Aziz Mohamed Deria (“the Movants”). The Debtor was present by counsel. The Movants were also present by counsel.

Upon consideration of the representations made by the parties at the hearing, the Affidavits of the moving parties, and the entire record in this case, and for the reasons stated on the record at the hearing, it is

ORDERED:

1. The motion is GRANTED. The automatic stay arising under 11 U.S.C. § 362(a) is modified (a) to allow the movants to proceed with the trial currently pending against the Debtor in the U.S. District Court for the Eastern District of Virginia; (b) to allow judgment to be entered; (c) to allow the filing and argument of any post-judgment motions; and (d) to allow the prosecution or defense of any appeals.
2. Relief is NOT GRANTED, however, to enforce any money judgment against any assets of the bankruptcy estate.
3. The Court waives the 14 day stay of this order that would otherwise be applicable under Fed.R.Bankr.P. 4001(a)(3).
