ORDER ON STIPULATION FOR EXTENSION, STAYING AND ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSING CASE CASE

THIS CAUSE is before the Court upon the parties' Stipulation for Extension of Time. (D.E. 29.)

THE COURT has considered the Motion and the pertinent portions of the record and is otherwise fully advised in the premises.

Counsel for Defendant has submitted an application to the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control ("OFAC") for a license to represent Defendant, Carlos Mario Jimenez Naranjo a.k.a "Macao," as a Specially Designated Narcotics Trafficker. *See* 31 C.F.R. § 536.312, ch. 5 app. (2009). The application remains pending, and Counsel for Defendant cannot provide legal service unless and until a license is granted. Counsel for Defendant was advised that the application process may take 90 days or longer and seeks an extension of all pending deadlines. However, the Court sees no reason why this case should not be stayed and administratively closed pending issuance of the license.

Accordingly, it is

ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the Stipulation (D.E. 29) is DENIED. It is further ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that the case is STAYED and shall be ADMINISTRATIVELY CLOSED by the Clerk pending issuance of the license. Within 5 days of issuance of the license, the parties shall notify the court in writing that the case may now proceed and at that time the Court will reset the relevant deadlines.
