MOTION TO DISMISS: LACK OF JURISDICTION OVER THE PERSON AND INSUFFICIENCY OF SERVICE OF PROCESS, INSUFFICIENCY OF PROCESS

COMES NOW the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, by and through his undersigned counsel, pursuant to FRCP 12(b)(2)(4) and (5) and Local Rule 7.1, moves this Court to dismiss the complaints filed herein and states:

- 1. Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, was never personally served a copy of any of the three complaints filed herein.
- 2. The process server did not deliver a copy of the summons or complaint originally filed herein to the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, but left it in a separate, adjacent room to where the Defendant was present but said room and the complaint and summons were not accessible

to the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN. Copies were not left with an individual of suitable age or any agent authorized by law to receive service.

- 3. Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, was incarcerated at Krome Detention Center at the time the process server allegedly served the summons and complaint.
- 4. The next day after the alleged service of process, the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, was deported to Haiti where he was immediately jailed until the day in March, 2004 that the democratically elected president of Haiti abandoned his post and country.
- 5. Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, was never served a copy of any complaint or summons filed herein.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, requests this Court dismiss the complaints filed herein or require the plaintiffs to properly serve the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN.

MEMORANDUM

FRCP 4(e) requires service on an individual in any judicial district of the United States to be:

- 1) Pursuant to the law of the state in which the district court is located, herein Florida, or;
- 2) By delivering a copy of the summons and complaint to the individual personally or by leaving copies thereof at the individual's dwelling house or usual place of abode with some

person of suitable age and discretion residing therein or by delivering a copy of the summons and

complaint to an agent authorized by appointment or by law to receive service of process.

Herein none of the above were complied with.

No attempt has been made by the Plaintiffs to comply with FRCP 4(f).

Without proper service of process this court has no jurisdiction of Defendant, CARL

DORELIEN.

WHEREFORE, the Defendant, CARL DORELIEN, prays this court dismiss the complaints

filed herein.
