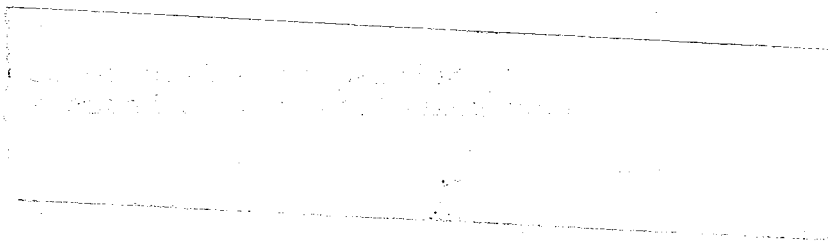
1 their claims are dismissed on the merits. Each party shall bear
