

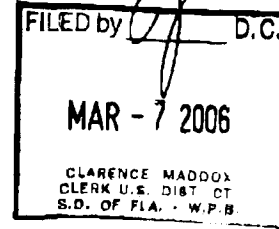

It is **ORDERED AND ADJUDGED**:


