DECLARATION OF MICHAELA. WEINSTEIN

- I, Michael Weinstein, hereby depose and say as follows:
- 1.) I am a citizen of the United States of America and am over the age of 18.
- 2.) I am Professor of Political Science at Purdue University, West Lafayette, Indiana.
- 3.) I publish regular analytical articles on Somali politics for Garoweonline, which is based in Puntland and is one of the two Somali sources regularly indexed on AllAfrica, one of the two Somali sources regularly indexed on Google News, and one of the five Somali sources regularly indexed on Lexis-Nexis. I have also written for the Center for Strategic and International Studies, and was on the keynote panel of the Center's 2009 conference on Somalia. I have participated in other conferences on Somalia, and have been interviewed as an expert by Reuters, Voice of America, and other publications. I have been a professor of political science for forty-five years and have published more than twenty books. My research on Somalia requires me to monitor international, regional, and local media each day I read an average of 60 articles every day, and also receive communications from concerned parties representing a wide diversity of viewpoints. I have been retained by defendant's counsel to opine on the taking of third-party depositions in

Ethiopia in the present instance.

- 4.) Attached to this Declaration as "Exhibit '1" is a true copy of my current *Curriculum Vitae* (abridged).
- 5.) The analytical basis for questioning having depositions taken in Ethiopia, when there are alternative sites in Kenya and Djibouti, is the entanglement of Ethiopia in Somaliland's politics, which is susceptible of creating an environment of anxiety and even fear in Somalilanders who would be deposed in Ethiopia. With regard to Somaliland, Ethiopia is not a detached or neutral party; Ethiopia is consistently involved in Somaliland's affairs due to the former's permanent security, economic, and political interests. The same is not the case for Djibouti's and particularly Kenya's relations with Somaliland.
- 6.) Ethiopia, indeed, was reported in June, 2011 to have sent a force into Somaliland and to have arrested a senior Somaliland commander, along with a group with which he was traveling in Wajaale town. Puntlandpost (June 15, 2011) reported that in recent months Ethiopia has made incursions into Somaliland over the border that they share "on more than ten occasions." Somaliland's foreign minister, Muhammad Abdullahi Omar, has denied that Ethiopia has undertaken such incursions.
- 7.) Puntlandpost maintains that "(r)elations between Ethiopia and the Somaliland administration have in recent months been under a lot of strain." Probing more deeply, Puntlandpost notes: "There are reports indicating that the Ethiopian government believes some in [Somaliland] President Ahmad Muhammad Silanyo's administration have links with commanders of rebel groups fighting the Ethiopian government. Somaliland [sic.] leader is also said to be maintaining covert relations with the Eritrean government thus Ethiopia's mistrust of

the current Somaliland administration." Puntlandpost also reports on Ethiopian concerns about links between Somaliland and groups fighting the state of Puntland that are alleged to have ties to al-Qaeda.

- 8.) In May, 2010 BBC News (May 22) reported that at least 13 people were killed "in a clash between Somalis and Ethiopian forces who had crossed the border. "The incident was in connection with an insurgent group fighting the Somaliland government.
- 9.) The point of recounting the above reports is that Ethiopia's involvement in Somaliland does not make it an ideal neutral site for taking depositions from Somailanders due to its fraught relations with Somaliland. As is seen from the two examples above, Ethiopia intervenes in Somailland on different sides, depending on its perceived interests in each case. This policy creates uncertainty about Ethiopia's intentions and could create anxiety on the parts of Somalilanders who would be deposed. To repeat, no involvement of this sort holds for Djibouti and Kenya. Kenya, in particular, does not have security and economic interests in Somaliland and does have facilities required for taking depositions.
- 10.) The opinion stated above is based on my considered professional judgment as a specialist in Somalia and more generally the Horn of Africa region. There is no evidence in the region of anywhere near the degree of involvement in Somaliland that Ethiopia has, and that involvement includes participation in conflicts in Somaliland.
